

Psalms 51-61 Discussion Questions

2. Psalm 51 is a beautiful, heartfelt confession of sin. He was sincere and God forgave him. After this, David acted on knowing he was forgiven. We must do the same. Has there been a time when you did not want to forgive yourself? Would you care to share?

Don't give Satan or your own flesh a foothold when God has forgiven you. If you are struggling with feeling forgiven, make sure you are truly sorry and have repented. If it keeps haunting you, write it out; confess it again; ask for forgiveness and then ask God to help you move on. Then take that paper, burn it, don't catch the house on fire, and move forward.

3. Ask the group to search for a few verses from today's lesson that help us to trust in God during times of trials or fear. Read those aloud.
