1. This week we had psalms of lament, thanksgiving, imprecatory, historical, as well as royal/Messianic and a little praise mixed in with all of these. As you are reading, meditating, and praying through these, are you able to personalize these? Would you like to share a portion of what you wrote?

2. Read Psalm 71:14, 15, 17-18, 23-24a. What is the common thread running through those verses? (We are to speak, proclaim, sing, and shout the praises and good deeds of God.) Make a point of doing that this week. I also encourage you to write a psalm/song of your own.

3. Psalms 73-78 were written by Asaph. What do you know about him?

3. Read Psalm 77:11-12. We are told to remember the deeds and wonders of God; to ponder His work and meditate on His mighty deeds. What are some deeds/wonders that God has worked in your life. It is good to recall those things and thank God for them. It is good to tell them to our children and grandchildren.
